Skills Canada – Nova Scotia (SCNS) is a not-for-profit organization that provides Nova Scotian youth with opportunities to explore and discover skilled trades and technologies through a range of programming. NOVA SCOTIA SKILLS COMPETITION & CAREER SHOWCASE

The Nova Scotia Skills Competition & Career Showcase brings together 250+ students and apprentices from across the province to compete in one of over 40 different contest areas in skilled trades and technologies. Winners are presented with gold, silver or bronze medals. Most gold medalists advance to the Skills Canada National Competition.

The Career Showcase is held in conjunction with the Nova Scotia Skills Competition and features over 30 interactive displays by Skills Canada - Nova Scotia (SCNS) partners. Over 2,000 junior and senior high school students are expected to tour the 2020 Nova Scotia Skills Competition event.
