2. Purpose of the Contest

The principal role of an Aesthetician is to perform services to enhance client physical and psychological well-being through manicures, hand and arm design SHANGHAI theme, facials and makeup. The challenge evaluates each competitor's readiness for employment and recognizes outstanding students for their excellence and professionalism in the aesthetics industry.

3. Criteria

4. Number of Stations / Allocations

There are eight (8) spaces available.

- Spaces will be filled on a first-come, first-serve basis up to a maximum of two (2) per school.
- If all spaces have not been filled before the deadline (March 5th), unfilled spaces will be filled on a first-come, first-serve basis from the waitlist.

5. Skills & Knowledge to be Tested

Manicure with nail art & Shanghai-themed hand/arm design

Objective:

- Perform a manicure;
- Analyze hands and fingernails;
- Record observations on the technical chart;
- Perform dry manicure, followed by the application of a gel base coat and gel polish, followed by the application of the posted nail art and finished with a gel top coat.
- No color bleeding or corrections;
- Clean and tidy the workstation;
- The competitor must incorporate the right hand & arm in a Shanghai theme. The competitor can use any medium for the hand & arm design and is responsible to bring their own supplies for this design.

Bridal makeup & mini facial

Objective: the competitor will do a bridal makeup application including:

- Foundation with corrective work;
 - Blush;
 - Highlighter;
 - Contouring;
 - Blended eye shadows;
 - Eyeliner;
 - Defined brows;
 - Lip liner and red lipstick only;
 - Application of strip lashes
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- ❖ Vision board must reflect the Shanghai theme of the hand & arm design;
 - ❖ Vision board may be of a material of the competitor's choice;
 - ❖ Vision board must be 8 inches by 10 inches;
 - ❖ Competitors must bring all supplies to perform the make up including brushes, head band, Q-tips, band lashes and glue and any other materials needed to complete their look;
 - ❖ A technical chart must be filled out prior to beginning to show face shape and the plan to balance and create harmony of the face;
 - ❖ All makeup products to complete the creative look must be provided by the competitor;

- ❖ Models are randomly assigned to competitors and therefore the competitor must be prepared for any skin tone (bring a variety of make up colors);
- ❖ Bridal make up to be applied to the whole face;
- ❖ Include contouring and highlighting to suit the models face shape;
- ❖ Band lashes must be applied;
- ❖ You can choose to bring bridal themed accessories to add to the overall look.

6. Prerequisites

SCNS Prerequisites

- Enrolled in a community college, university or private school OR be registered as an apprentice with the Department of Labour and Advanced Education;
- Registered as a competitor with Skills Canada – Nova Scotia (SCNS);
- The competitor cannot be a certified journey-person;
- The competitor must possess a Canadian citizenship or landed immigrant status and be a resident of Nova Scotia. Competitors are responsible for verifying this information if requested;
- Have been earning post-secondary credits any time during the academic school year (September to June);
- All competitors must be able to show either current apprenticeship status and/or proof of enrollment in a post-secondary institution upon request of the Provincial Technical Committee (PTC) or SCNS.

a) What Will Be Supplied

- Technical chart;

- Gel polish base coat, top coat and nail polish.

Bridal makeup & mini facial

Bridal makeup & mini facial

Makeup products are NOT supplied. Competitors must bring their own makeup products and supplies.

- Makeup brushes;
- Accessories;
 - False lashes + glue;
 - Hair accessories;
 - Rhinestones;
 - Feathers;
 - Apparel;
- Full cutting / cover-up cape;
- Headband / hair clips;(this can be used for both facial & makeup)
- Tweezers;
- Spatulas;
- Q-tips;
- Sponges;
- Tissues;
- Disposable mascara wands;
- Any combination of makeup products that competitors need to complete the desired outcome.

- Cotton rounds
- Head bands
- Sheets
- Blanket
- Towels needed for facial
- All products needed for facial:
 - Eye & lip remover;
 - Makeup remover;
 - Exfoliant;
 - Toner;
 - Mask (must be clay based);

8. Evaluation & Judging Criteria

Item	Point Value
Manicure with hand/arm design	30 points
Bridal makeup & mini facial	20 points
Total Score	50 points

In the event of a tie in scoring, the following procedure will apply:

- The competitor with the highest score in the most heavily weighted area of the competition will be declared the winner.
- If there is still a tie, the winner will be declared by the highest score in makeup.
