Assignment - Showing Emotions.

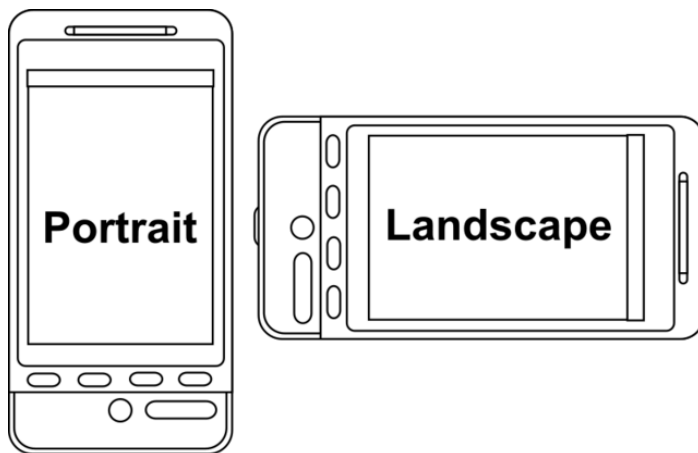
During a competition like the Nova Scotia Skills Competition, people might experience strong emotions, whether they are a competitor, judge or member of the public.

Your assignment is to choose three emotions and take three photographs of people that you think represents these emotions. You can choose any **three** from the following:

- **Joy**- pleasant and deep emotion of satisfaction and intense happiness.
- **Anger** - strong emotion of discontent, frustration that can be accompanied by aggressiveness.
- **Sadness** - painful emotion that causes grief, melancholy caused an accident or mistake.
- **Fear** - emotion that accompanies the awareness of a danger, a threat or a loss.
- **Disgust**- emotion that expresses disgust, repulsion, rejection.
- **Surprise** - emotion provoked by an unexpected information or event.

You can choose to make your photographs black & white or colour.

Each participant will print their three photographs onto photo paper, and stick it on a white mat frame provided. You will need to submit **one portrait image** and **one landscape image**.



Participants can give their photographs a title if they wish to. This photograph will be presented during an exhibition that afternoon. At the end of the event, they will submit their work to the judges.

Equipment

Participants will need to provide their own camera equipment. This could be in the form of a DSLR or mirrorless camera, a cell phone camera or instant film. Participants are allowed the use of a tripod. Participants will need to provide a memory card for their camera.

Skills Canada Nova Scotia will provide access to a desktop computer and an email address to submit the photos to.

Editing software will not be required for this task.
