Skills Canada – Nova Scotia (SCNS) is a non-profit organization that provides youth the opportunity to explore careers in skilled trades and technologies. We offer programming across the province through partnerships with industry, government, labour, and education.

NOVA SCOTIA SKILLS COMPETITION

Over 35 different trade and technology skill areas are showcased in the annual Nova Scotia Skills Competition. The competitions offer an opportunity for students and apprentices across the province to compete in their respective areas, demonstrate their unique abilities, enhance their skills, and strive for excellence. Bronze, silver, and gold medals are awarded to the top 3 competitors in each skill area. Most gold medalists advance to compete as a part of Team Nova Scotia in the Skills Canada National Competition. Competition registration opens in January of each year.

SKILLED FUTURES IN-SCHOOL PRESENTATIONS

In-class presentations continue to be one of SCNS's most effective tools for promoting careers in skilled trades and technologies to Nova Scotian youth. Our free, engaging, interactive hour-long Skilled Futures In-School Presentation offers information on skilled trades and technologies, promotes career exploration, and gets students thinking about their own personal strengths, and passions in life.

SKILLS FOR SUCCESS WORKSHOPS

SCNS offers fun and educational workshops illustrating how the 9 Skills for Success are essential to careers in skilled trades and technologies. Students complete collaborative activities highlighting the importance of skills such as numeracy, reading, adaptability, and communication.

Nova Scotia's 13,000 km of coastline offers incredible careers in skilled trades and marine technology. In partnership with Irving Shipbuilding Inc., We're bringing Discover Marine Trades to classrooms across the province, helping students discover exciting opportunities in our growing marine sector.

Our Skilled Futures Career Showcase welcomes thousands of students each year to tour our interactive industry-led exhibits and to participate in Try-a-Trade® activities showcasing a variety of careers in skilled trades and technologies.

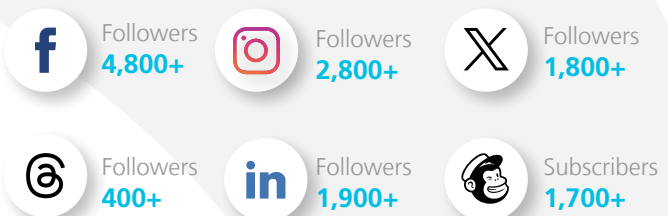
ACCESSIBILITY SERVICES

The Nova Scotia Skills Competition & Career Showcase brings together 250+ students and apprentices from across the province to compete in one of over 40 different contest areas in skilled trades and technologies. Winners are presented with gold, silver, or bronze medals.

Most gold medalists advance to the Skills Canada National Competition as part of Team Nova Scotia. Over 30 sectors will be represented in competition.

The Abilympics (Olympics of Abilities) is a program held as part of the Nova Scotia Skills Competition. It is designed to provide persons with disabilities the opportunity to demonstrate their unique talents and skills in a relaxed, inclusive, and accessible competition setting.

The competition runs alongside the Nova Scotia Skills Competition at various locations throughout the province. Winners of the Nova Scotia competition may go on to represent Team Canada at the International Abilympics.

The Nova Scotia Skills Competition and Career Showcase events attract over 1,000 junior and senior high school students annually. The events open doors to careers in trades and technologies, giving students the opportunity to explore hands-on activities, connect with industry representatives, and discover interests that could shape their future.

The showcases are hosted four times a year as standalone events and in conjunction with the Nova Scotia Skills Competition. Each year we ensure that we visit rural areas outside of the HRM, in addition to at least one HRM event.

SKILLS CANADA NATIONAL COMPETITION

The Skills Canada National Competition brings together more than 500 competitors representing every province and territory to compete in over 40 skilled trade and technology competitions in front of thousands of spectators. Most gold medalists from the Nova Scotia Skills Competition join Team Nova Scotia and compete at the Skills Canada National Competition held in a different city each year. Participation in this prestigious event requires funding to support competitor training, travel, and team activities.

TEAM NOVA SCOTIA SPONSOR – \$10,000

Gold medalists from our Nova Scotia Skills Competition are invited to join Team Nova Scotia to compete at the Skills Canada National Competition. INTERNATIONAL ABILYMPICS COMPETITION

The International Abilympics competition for professionals showcases the vocational skills of persons with disabilities on an international stage. There is no age limit for the competition. Abilympics helps raise awareness of the right of professionals in need of special support to find employment and showcases the competence they have to offer to meet the needs of the world of work.

Nova Scotia continues to lead the efforts for Team Canada, aiming to inspire participation from other provinces and territories. Five Nova Scotians represented Team Canada at the last International Abilympics, held in Metz, France in 2023. Approximately 400 competitors from 27 countries participated in 44 skill categories. Team Canada returned with 5 medals, four bronze and a medallion of excellence.

Competing at the International Abilympics involves significant costs, which are the responsibility of SCNS. We are seeking your support to help offset expenses related to travel, team uniforms, competition tools and supplies, as well as the consumable materials required to properly prepare our competitors.
